

## The Parable of the Unmerciful Servant Activity Page 2

Jesus told this parable to show us how important it is for us to forgive. If we forgive, God can forgive us! But Jesus didn't tell us to just say the words, "It's okay" or "I forgive you": He told us to really mean the words when we say them. How *did* He say we need to forgive others? Do some letter math to find out! (Letter math works like this: start at the letter given. For addition, move forward in the alphabet as many letters as listed. For subtraction, move backwards in the alphabet. For example, if the clue says A+5, the answer is F!)
